Regional Leaders from Across Oregon's 5th Congressional District Celebrate McLeod-Skinner's In-Person Launch

McLeod-Skinner Challenges Primary Opponents to a "Keep It Clean" Pledge

BEND, Ore. -- Community leaders and grassroots supporters from across Oregon's 5th Congressional District met in Bend on Sunday to celebrate the in-person launch of Jamie McLeod-Skinner's run for Congress.
